The Intermodal Association of North America (IANA) is the only organization that represents the combined interests of the intermodal freight transportation industry. IANA aims to promote the growth of efficient intermodal freight transportation through innovation, education, and dialogue. IANA's *Scholarship Program* seeks to progress the education of the intermodal freight transportation industry's next generation of leaders and managers and over the past ten years, IANA has awarded more than \$2 million to support students in university programs focused on freight and intermodal transportation.

The IANA Scholarship Program offered through the Center for International Trade & Transportation (CITT) at California State University, Long Beach recognizes the value of industry specific training and experience to enhance career success and ability to contribute to the intermodal freight transportation industry. The IANA Scholarship Program at CSULB/CITT offers:

1. Scholarships for CSULB students to enroll in CITT's Global Logistics Specialist (GLS) ([www.ccpe.csulb.edu/gls](http://www.ccpe.csulb.edu/gls)) and/or the Marine Terminal Operations Professional (MTO) ([www.ccpe.csulb.edu/mtop](http://www.ccpe.csulb.edu/mtop)) program to gain an industry recognized professional designation complementing skill sets developed in the applicant's academic program with industry skills and knowledge typically acquired through work experience and exposure to interrelationships between industry stakeholders.
2. Two scholarships of \$2500 each to participate in a work-based learning experience in the field of logistics and transportation.

IANA Scholars will be encouraged to:

- Participate in industry networking activities, conferences, seminars, and association meetings
- Participate in a work-based learning experience in the field of logistics and transportation

### Eligibility Criteria:

- Must be a CSULB junior, senior or recent CSULB graduate (within the last 12 months)
- Must demonstrate commitment to completing all GLS or MTO program requirements and
- Professional interest in transportation- or logistics-related fields

- One academic or business reference. Business reference should be immediate supervisor.
- Resume
- Response to essay question (see application)
- Copy of college/university level transcripts
