



Joey Carnes

Chairman and Chief Executive Officer

As chairman and chief executive officer of MIQ Logistics, a \$500 million global logistics company, Joey Carnes is responsible for the overall global performance of the company. MIQ Logistics specializes in international freight forwarding, customs brokerage, transportation management, truckload services and dedicated warehouse and fulfillment services in North America, Latin America, Europe and Asia. Along with a global network partners, it provides services in and between more than 80 countries supported by over 5,000 in-country logistics professionals. Carnes joined the company at the time of its acquisition in 2010.

Before coming to MIQ Logistics, Carnes was president and CEO of BAX Global Inc., a \$3 billion global supply chain company with over 15,000 employees. He joined BAX in 1999 as president of U.S. and Canada, and played an integral part in transforming the company into one of the leading supply chain providers in the industry. With the company's sale to Deutsche Bahn AG in 2006, Carnes was responsible for overseeing the integration of BAX Global and Schenker AG with a specific focus on customer integration and network capabilities.

Prior to joining BAX, Carnes was the executive vice president at Fritz Companies, Inc., with total P&L responsibility for North America and the FedEx clearance operations in Memphis, Tenn., Anchorage, Alaska and Oakland, Calif. During his 12 years with Fritz, he was instrumental in the growth of the organization, which included 50 acquisitions that moved the company from \$100 million in revenue to over \$1.2 billion.

Carnes started his career in the industry with the U.S. Customs Service in 1976. Over the last 35 years he has held leading positions and was responsible for directing the changes necessary to respond to the ever-changing market conditions.
